




Consider the Poor – Vision Statement

The mission of CTP is carried out in the following 3 phases:


Individual Service (generous giving)

Collective Voice (invite those who have to share with those in need)




2017 Organizational Goals Status





2017 Accomplishments



- Foreign Missions

Food provided for orphans, widows, and elderly in India. Blankets provided for people in Bangladesh with modest homes.

- Local Missions

Connection made with 412 Food Rescue and St. John's Community Kitchen for future missions. Ground work complete for weekend food sacks.

- Infrastructure

360% increase in social media engagement to broadcast the needs of the poor!

- Organizational Goals

2 of 3 goals met. 400% increase in the number of people impacted by CTP missions.

- Board Development

Bruce Appelt added as 4th board member of Consider the Poor.

2017 Missions – Food for India



Hope Home Orphanage

In 2017 we connected with Dr. Ravindra Babu, Pastor of Vision of Hope Ministries and Director of Hope Home Orphanage. Over the holidays we provided meals for the 15 children living at the orphanage in Tenali, India.



We also provided food for Vision of Hope Ministries' Christmas celebration. 300 people enjoyed the Christmas story and dinner including orphans, widows, elderly and local members of the community.



2017 Missions – Blankets for Bangladesh



Blankets for those with modest homes!

In December we supported Missionary Khokon Beapare's trip to the hilly area of Bangladesh by providing blankets for the poor. Many live in homes that offer little protection from the wind and cold.

Missionary Beapare who has been traveling to this area for several years delivered 20 blankets for us to families in need. Blankets were purchased locally to help the businesses there.



2017 Missions – New Church in Brazil

This year Consider the Poor supported Brazil's Missao Internacional Maanaim (International Mission Tomorrow) in the opening of a new church.



This church was opened in Santa Rita, a poor city in the state of Paraiba.



2017 Missions – Brazil English Classes



Brazil Bible School Free English Classes

In 2017 we completed our support of Dr. Guimaraes' free English classes for Brazilian missionaries.

This critical skill will support them in their own missions work, as well as provided them with an edge in job qualifications.

With the support of our partners, this funding provided a monthly salary for two English teachers as well.
